PURPOSE

- Promote help seeking

INSTRUCTIONS

Materials

- Cut out leprechaun footprints or rainbows
- (Optional) Chocolate coins
- Container (the "pot of gold") to hold the chocolate

Assembly

1. Cut out out leprechaun footprints or rainbows and post them in the school leading to the counselor and/or social worker offices.
2. Fill a pot with chocolate coins and place in counselor and/or social worker offices

Application

- Many students don't know where the counselor and/or social worker offices are in their school. It's very important that students know where in your building they can go for help if they need it for themselves or a friend. Have students create a fun scavenger hunt that can solve that with a "pot of gold" at the end in the social worker's or counselor's office!
- Make an announcement and encourage people to stop by for a piece of chocolate.
