Create a <u>Resource Portal Account</u>

- All material will be accessed through the Resource Portal
- Club Advisors are required to have a Resource Portal Account
- Club members (students) are encouraged to have a Resource Portal Account so that they can access materials and the ChangeMakers Network

Register your Official Empowerment Club*

- When naming your Empowerment Club, Official Clubs must use "Erika's Lighthouse" in your club name and any materials created (for example: "Erika's Lighthouse + Club name of choice")
- Student Club members are highly encouraged to have a Resource Portal account so they can communicate with other club members across the country on the Erika's Lighthouse ChangeMakers Network

Mental Health Student Leadership Academy:

- · Student club members must have some mental health training
- Mental Health Student Leadership Academy video modules & discussion questions can be found under the "Empowerment Clubs (Official and Affiliate) tab in the Resource Portal
- Clubs can use what is provided (our Mental Health Student Leadership Academy video modules & discussion questions) OR create your own club member-led education with Erika's Lighthouse-provided slides and talking points.

Lead at least one Awareness Into Action Activity per quarter

- Awareness into Action Activities should be shoolwide
- Clubs can use an activity provided by Erika's Lighthouse or one created by your club.
- Awareness into Action Activities can be found under the "Awareness into Action Activities (AAAs) Tab in the Resource Portal and have activities sorted by type

Fill out the <u>Awareness into Action Activity Report</u>

- Awareness into Action Activity Report is required for reimbursement
- Upload any applicable receipts for reimbursement
- Upload photos of the activity if you have some to show us how it went
- Tell us what you thought of the activity and how it went
