- Paint pens
- Clear paint sealer (optional)

Application

- Create a rock garden with a sign to encourage students to take what they need
- Leave rocks in random places to brighten someone's day
- Hand out rocks at lunch or arrival/dismissal

Assembly

- 1. Wash rocks to remove debris
- 2. Paint a base coat on one side of the rock and let dry
- 3. Use paint pens to write an inspirational message see below for ideas!
- 4. Once dry, use clear paint sealer if desired to preserve paint
