



St. Patrick's Day Pot of Gold Scavenger Hunt

We know from the hundreds classroom presentations we facilitate every year that a high percentage of high school students don't know where the social workers' offices are at their school. It's very important that students know where in your building they can go for help if they need it for themselves or a friend.

This month, you might design a scavenger hunt that ends up at the social workers' offices so students get more familiar with where they can go for help. One idea is to do a St. Patrick's Day themed scavenger hunt where students find the pot of gold at the end of the rainbow. You could fill a pot with chocolate coins and put it in the social workers' office. Make an announcement and encourage people to stop by for a piece of chocolate gold. You could have "leprechaun footprints" or "rainbows" leading a trail to the social workers' offices or come up with another St. Patrick's Day themed scavenger hunt idea.
